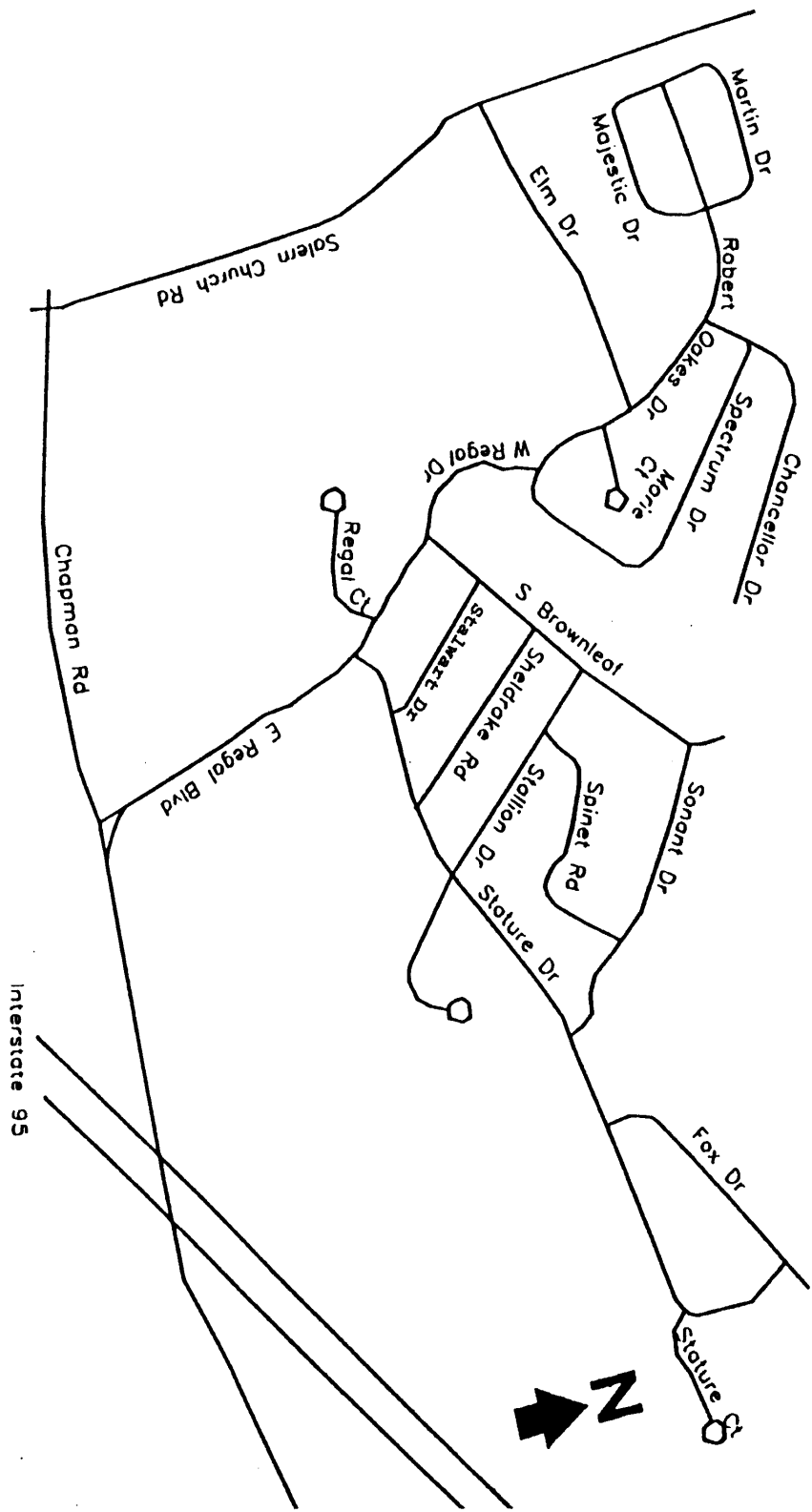
## Voting
